## 2017 World Wake Surfing Championship Qualifying Criteria

Centurion & Supreme Boats, in conjunction with the Competitive Wake Surf Association, is proud to announce the criteria to qualify for an invitation to compete in the 22<sup>nd</sup> World Wake Surfing Championship:

- To be considered for an invitation to WWSC17 for the 2017 Competition year, an athlete must be a CWSA member in good standing and prior to September 11, 2017 compete in the below total minimum number of CWSA sanctioned events. The total events shall include a minimum number of World Series of Wake Surfing events as below, and *may* include one (1) WRS Qualified event.

Pro	3	1	4
Outlaw	2	1	3
Amateur, Masters, Juniors	1	1	2

- For each recognized Division in the 2017 CWSA World Ranking System (WRS), the top WRS ranked athletes as scored by the CWSA for events completed by September 11, 2017, who have met the requirements of paragraph 1, will qualify for and receive an invitation to compete in the 2017 World Wake Surfing Championship.

Skill Level/Gender	WRS Ranked Athletes for WWSC17 Invitations per Division
Pro, Outlaw, Amateur – Men & Women	Top 10
Juniors – Combined	Top 10
Masters – Men	Top 8
Masters – Women	Top 6

- Centurion & Supreme Boats reserves the absolute right, but is not obligated, to extend invitations to more than the designated number of top WRS ranked athletes in a particular division, or divisions, in order of WRS rank of the athlete in that Division or Divisions as of September 11, 2017.
- If a qualified athlete declines an invitation for any reason, including not registering or not responding to an invitation, that invitation may, in the sole discretion of the Promoter, be offered to the next highest qualified WRS ranked athlete in that Division as of September 11, 2017. The Promoter is not obligated to extend any invitation to any competitor other than as set forth above in Paragraphs 1 and 2.
- Centurion & Supreme Boats, as the Promoter of the World Wake Surfing Championship, reserves the absolute right, but is not obligated, to invite “Promoter’s Choice” athletes in any CWSA recognized Division, regardless of whether or not such athlete has participated in a 2017 World Series of Wake Surfing event or a 2017 WRS Qualified event, and regardless of such athlete’s WRS rank, or lack of rank, as of September 11, 2017.
